Lucienne Arnold and her team set the dates for our events, purchase the items, put tablecloths and center pieces in place, even sweep the floor, arrange for our wonderful wine stewards (Jack Twa and Dick Moore) and clean up after. This too is a lot of work. They come 2 hours before the event just to set up and stay after for clean up. Thank you.

As I said at the Annual Meeting it is each of you. Thank you to each of you who hosted the MTA, Meet the Artist, events: Joy and Maurice McCormick, Judy and Chuck Cuffaro, Karen and Lloyd Jackson, Margaret and Jerry Colmer and Charlotte Martin. Special thanks to Judy Cuffaro who hosted on her birthday and anniversary.

We presently have 130 members. We received \$59,123 from grants (thanks to Jack Kukuk and Ray Cunningham). Ticket sales of \$64,350, Program Ads of \$8,000 and \$22,000 for membership. Our projected expenses for next year are \$196,715, about \$40,000 higher than this year. We do have carryover from this year and will have six, not five, shows next year. Our memberships, grants, ads and ticket sales fund our artists and the residencies for music. Please encourage your friends and neighbors to become members and to purchase tickets to concerts.

Each of you contribute to our success whether by being a member, attending concerts, serving on a committee, working at the Arts Festival, obtaining ads, helping with the Leland Wilson Art Project or music residencies, ushering, bringing food, etc., etc. THANK YOU. As a Board we honor you. The BOD has a fiduciary responsibility to carry forward the mission of GCAC. I believe in service leadership and it is my honor to serve you and students.
