Dear Dr. Kukuk.

It is with a heavy heart.....That I find myself not in Gold Canyon right now, enjoying both the hospitality of and performing for the Gold Canyon Arts Council. Our time with you January 12-13 was memorable, and we in the Folk Legacy Trio are honored to have made such wonderful new friends.

Through the years each of us in the group has done in-school outreach programs. Few were as well conceived as the three sponsored by your Arts Council. The school principals and teachers had prepared their students, with guidelines of discipline if not actual knowledge of music. We were particularly taken with the San Carlos High School students taught by Tony Gatewood. His Lead Guitar students were well disciplined and have responded well to the opportunity given to them with this program taught by Mr. Gatewood. His leadership of these students was obvious and their response to him justified the trust they obviously had placed in him.

The presentation of a learning program for these students, balanced in different disciplines of music from classical to folk to pop, may prove to be one of the most beneficial programs in these students' lives, introducing them not only to styles of music they may never have heard or chosen to listen to, but also establishing a focus they may never have known they owned. One never knows what will speak to a young person, especially when it is presented with care and honesty.

All of the people we met who were involved with the Gold Canyon Arts Council accepted us as though we were old friends. I much prefer the term "well-seasoned" friends, and the acceptance of us both as artists and as friends was genuine. It isn't easy carrying the banner as "The World's Oldest Boy-Band", but everyone in the Arts Council made us feel as that was a cloak we could proudly wear. This is something I shall share with other artist friends of mine, inclusive of everything from the school programs to our concert to the beautiful reception a private home after the show.

Thank you for welcoming the Folk Legacy Trio into your community. But more so, thank you for what you are doing for the young people in your area through the Gold Canyon Arts Council. That is how character is built: through the continuation of the arts, the one true culture that we all share.
